Accreditation requests to be made using a New Online Self-service Portal

Nairobi, 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2020 - The Media Council of Kenya (MCK), wishes to notify all stakeholders that effective immediately, accreditation services will **STRICTLY** be provided through the new online self-service portal: <u>https://accreditation.mediacouncil.or.ke:882</u> available on the MCK's website, <u>https://www.mediacouncil.or.ke</u>

The MCK has since ceased its earlier modes of application received on email and hard copy formats. All new applicants are therefore advised to ensure that they upload the required scanned copies of documents needed for the process.

Accordingly, all Special Media Passes (SMPs) issued by MCK will expire on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020. Journalists holding the SMPs and those with expired press cards are requested to make fresh application for the year 2021.
