- be trained on salient and emerging issues in climate

ToT applicants should possess the following:

- Experience in journalism and communication skills,
- Knowledge of the media in Kenya and the climate change scene;
- Familiarity with Climate change issues,
- Fluency in English, Kiswahili and possibly an additional UN language,
- Ability to work within a culturally diverse workforce;
- Capacity to provide feedback in a constructive manner;
- Self-motivated, innovative and resourceful;
- Responsive to participants' needs of participants
